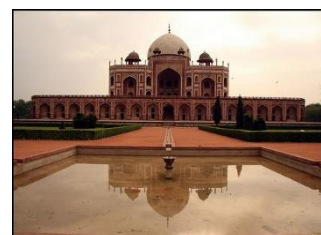

Delhi the traditional and present-day capital of India is a strategic point in northern India and has been a coveted prize for conquerors since time immemorial. Tradition places its beginning at c. 1450 B.C.E. but Delhi's history can be reconstructed more accurately after 800 C.E., since then eight cities have been constructed in the same area. The Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan built the seventh city of Delhi, Shahjahanabad, in 1648 containing the famous Red Fort and Jama Masjid. The British moved their Capital from Calcutta to Delhi in 1911 and another city, New Delhi, was constructed according to the majestic plans of Edwin Lutyens. When India became independent in 1947, New Delhi continued to be its Capital. Thus, Delhi has successively been a Capital city to princes, sultans, viceroys, and contemporary parliamentary government.

Jaipur takes its name from the famous astronomer prince, Maharaja Jai Singh who founded the city when he moved his capital from the fortress of Amber in 1727. Jaipur was laid out in a rectangular grid and has at its center the City Palace from which radiate the oleander pink buildings, domes and minarets. Jaipur is encircled on all but the southern side by the rugged Aravali hills with numerous peaks crowned by imposing forts. This legendary "Pink City" is the capital of Rajasthan, built to accommodate 25,000 inhabitants and is now overtaken by the vast population increases and rural-urban migrations of the post-independence period.

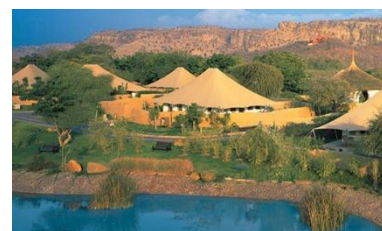

The **Ranthambore** National Park is home to the Royal Bengal Tiger, apart from being one of the most picturesque game reserves in the world. Located near the town of Sawai Madhopur, which is around 180 km south east of Jaipur in Rajasthan. It was established as a sanctuary in 1959 and included in the very first phase of Project Tiger in 1972. In 1981, Ranthambore was awarded the status of a National Park. The park derives its name from the 11th century fort of Ranthambore, which sits on a rocky outcrop in the forest. The fort was a vital citadel for the control of central India. Though overrun by vegetation, remnants of the summer palaces, temples and guard stones within the fort still remain.
